Where has Daily Bread moved to?

Daily Bread is moving into a beautiful new (and much larger) space in the Hayman Kronfeld Building, opposite Britomart Transport Centre on Galway St, opening February 2023. In the meantime, kingi can help you with all your coffee needs.

What will be coming to this space?

'kingi private' will be opening in April 2023.

What is kingi private?

A refined private dining, gathering and function space, designed to host meals for up to 14 people or board meetings and small conferences for up to 12 people.

What will the space be like?

The space will bring together the relaxed warmth of kingi and the refined elegance of The Libraries. An expansive kauri table seats up to 14 people or can split into a 10-person table and a 4-person table. The glassed portion of the space will showcase an open 'larder kitchen', where diners and passers-by in the kingi courtyard can enjoy watching our seasonal dishes being prepared. For meetings and conferences, curtains on the north wall draw back to unveil a concealed audio-visual system with a 65" touchpad screen, speakers, conferencing speaker and high-speed internet.
